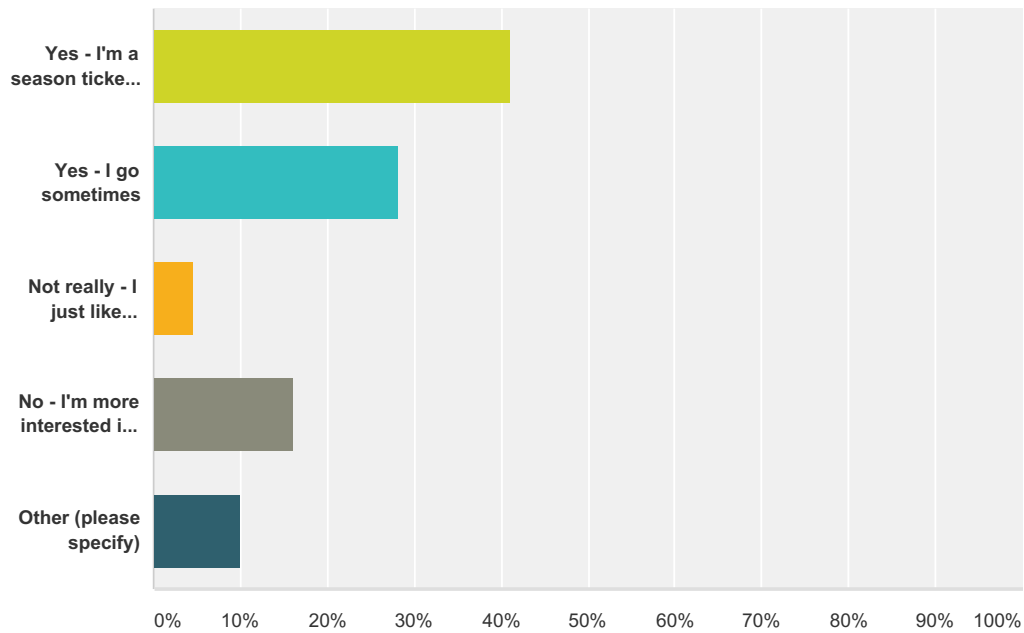


Q1 First of all, would you describe yourself as a Bath City fan?

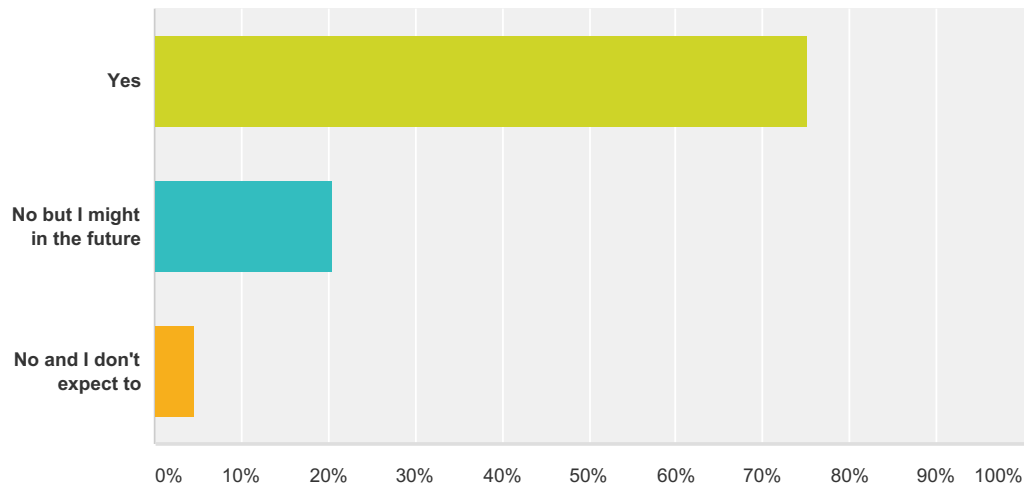

Q2 Have you pledged to buy community shares in the new Bath City?

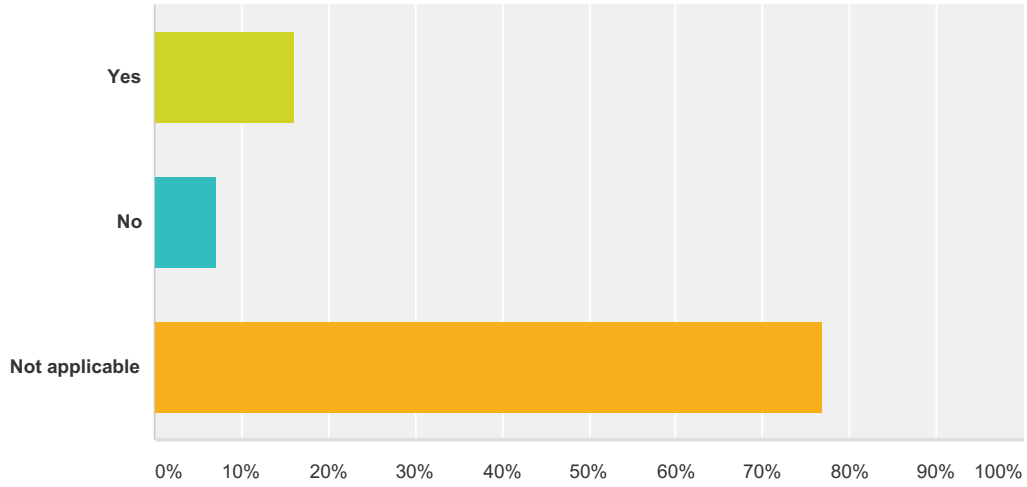

Q3 If you already hold shares in the existing Bath City Ltd company, did you pledge to vote for conversion to a Community Benefit Society

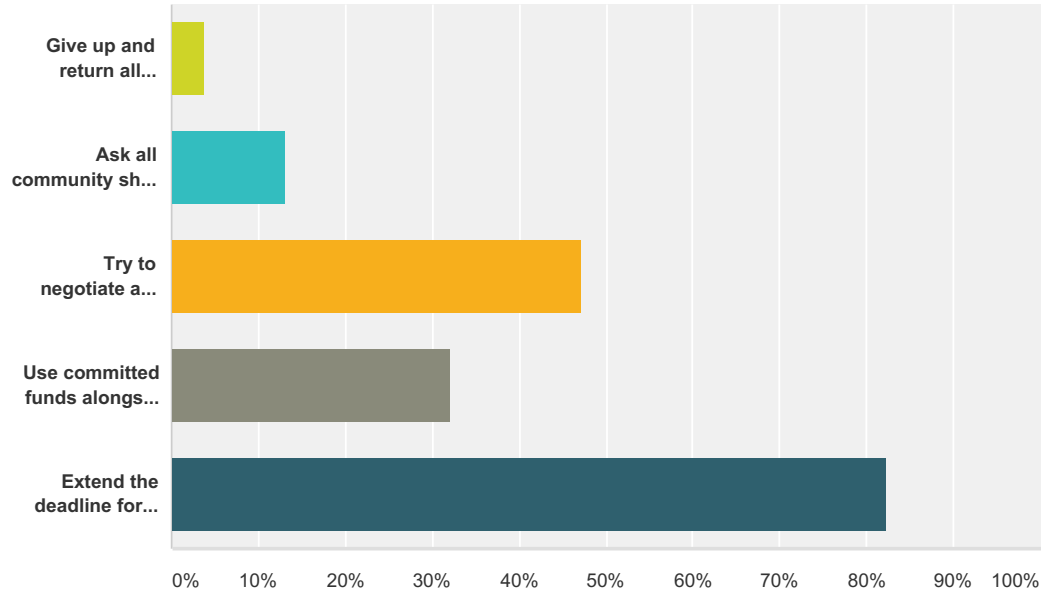

Q4 What do you think the next steps should be? (please tick all that are acceptable to you)

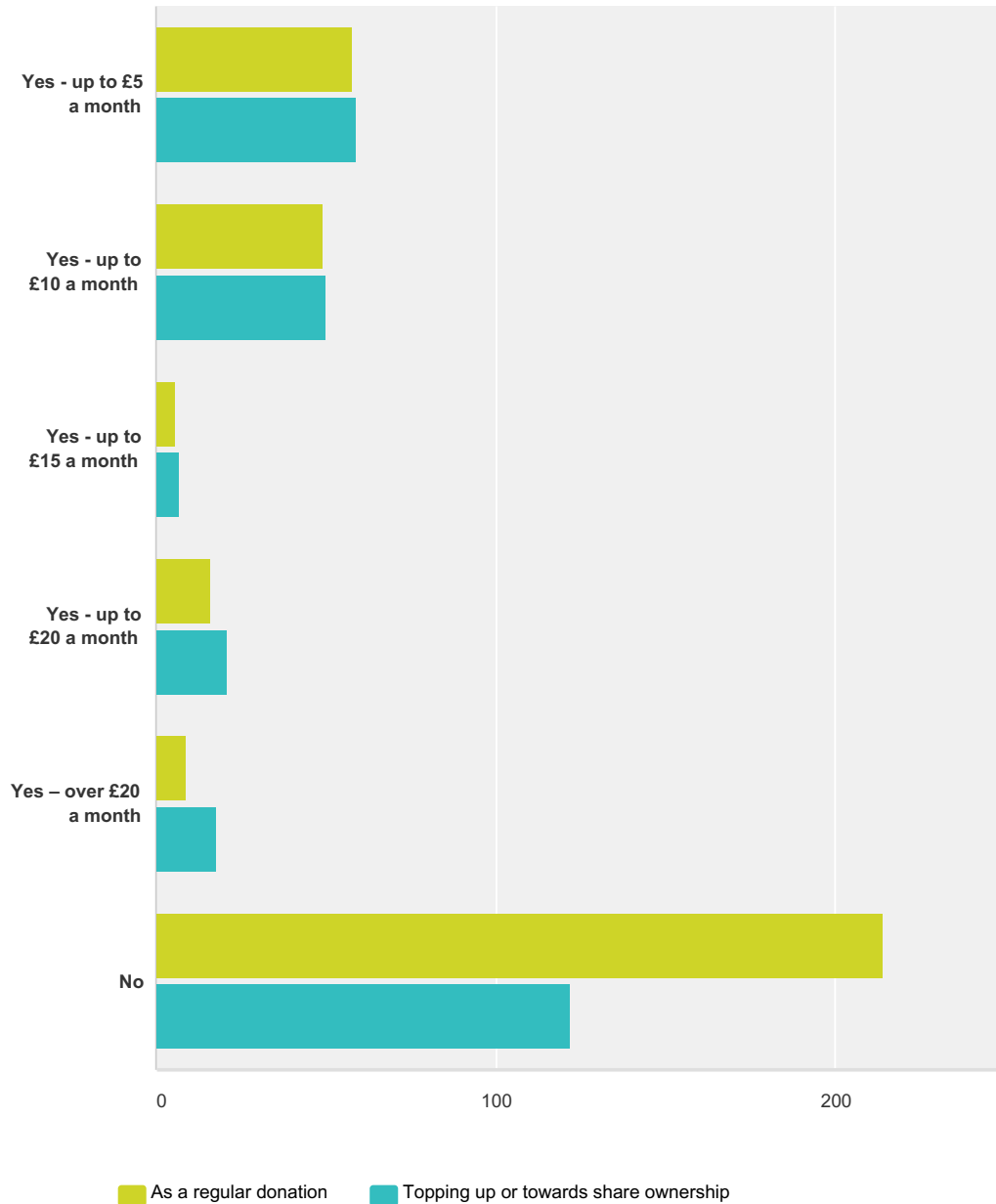

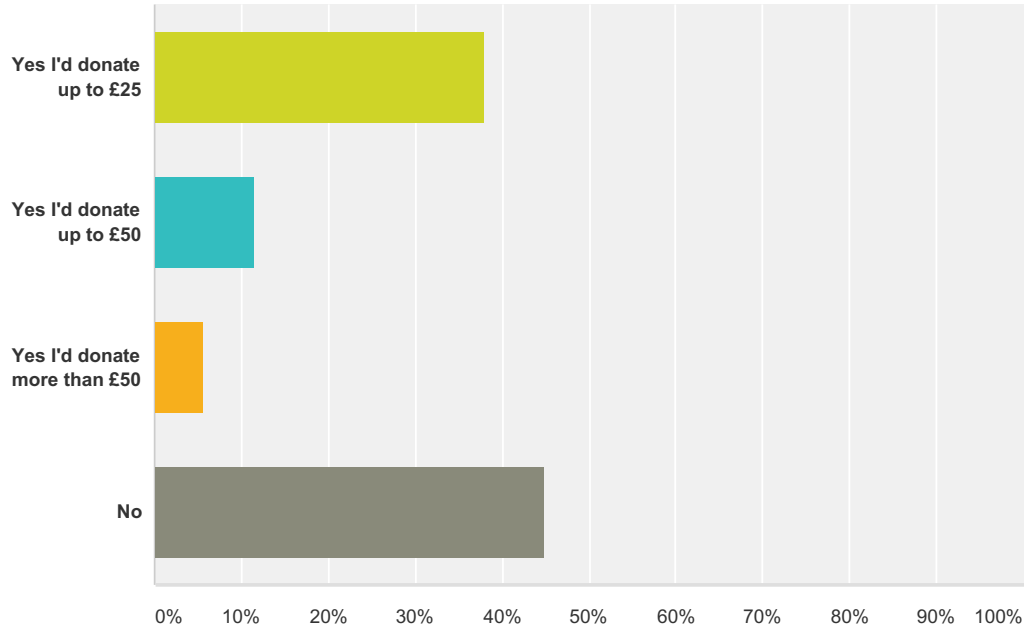

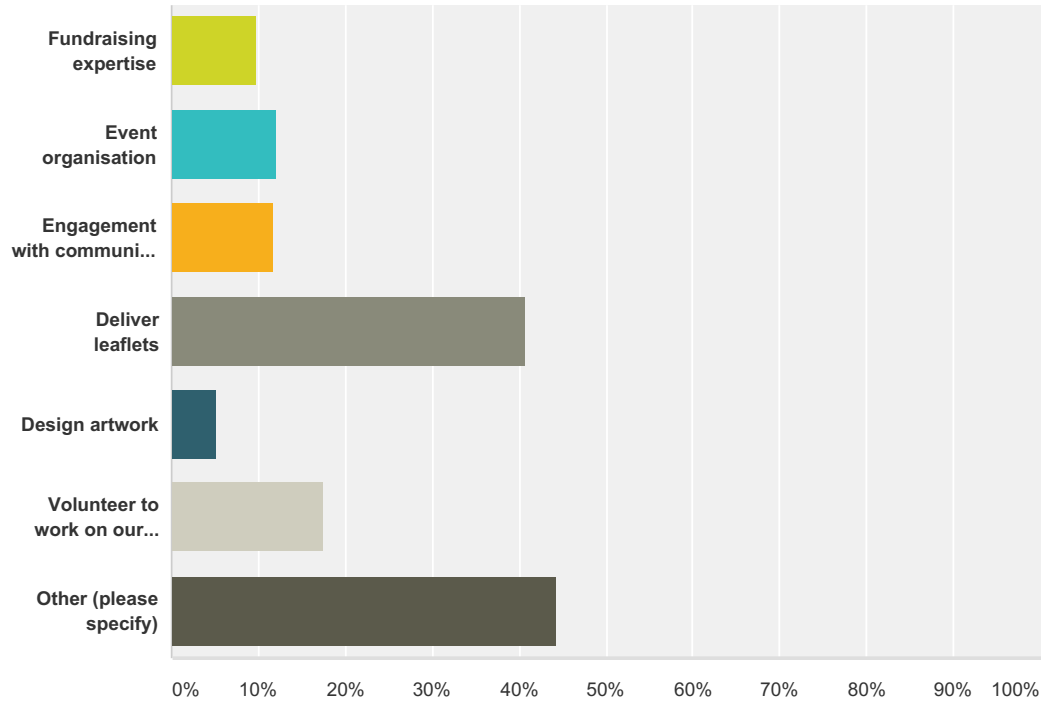
